Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to the start of the new school term, we would like to wish you all a Happy New Year and say thank you for the good wishes, cards and presents Mrs Greeves and I received at Christmas.

This letter is to tell you about class routines, topics and homework your child will be working through during the next few weeks. The topic we are learning about this half term is Knights and Castles, In Science we will be learning about Ourselves, R.E is Judaism and in our computing lessons we will be researching topics and learning about simple algorithms.

P.E. days will be Tuesdays and Fridays. Children will need shorts, jogging bottoms in colder weather, t-shirt and trainers or plimsolls when working outside. It is advisable that children bring their P.E. kit into school on a Monday and leave it on their peg during the week.

Our class assembly will be held on the 14th March at 9am. This is where we share some of our learning and you are invited to come and watch.

Children are expected to bring their reading folder and water bottle to school every day. Children should keep their reading book and reading record in the book folder. Please support your child by reading with them regularly. Children should share their reading book with parents/carers and other family members every evening. Discussion about the book also contributes to your child's learning. Please add

comments and/or initial in the reading record so that we know when your child's book needs changing.

We will also be changing our library books on a Friday afternoon and taking some time to share books in the library, could you please ensure that your children have their library books in school on a Friday morning.

Times tables are a key element to maths learning. Children are expected to learn their x 2, x 5 and x 10 during Year 1 and Year 2. We will also be sending other pieces of homework home throughout the coming weeks.

If you have any questions about your child's learning or classroom routines please do not hesitate to ask. It is always best to book an appointment with me after school so that the class is not disturbed. This can be done through the school office staff.
